IF YOU...

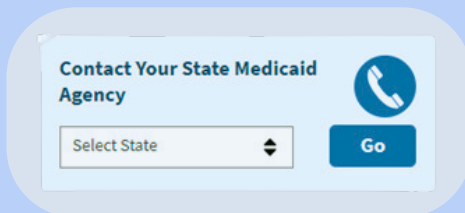
PLANNING TO MOVE OUT OF MAINE?

As of 01/01/23, Youth who turn 18 while in foster care in any state, are eligible for Medicaid coverage up to age 26 in every state!*

(Remember to contact OCFS and get a letter to take with you that verifies the dates you were in foster care in Maine.)

Find the office to sign up for Medicaid in another state by going to:

- Were in foster care in Maine when you turned 18.
- Renew every year to continue your coverage.

REMEMBER: Being in foster care at the age of 18 is what makes you eligible for coverage, not your income or assets (or those of anyone else in your home).
